

TOWN OF PERINTON LEGAL NOTICE
AMENDMENT TO THE
CODE OF THE TOWN OF PERINTON

LOCAL LAW #4 OF 2019
SECTION 208-23
KEEPING OF ANIMALS

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that at a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Perinton, to be held at Town Hall, 1350 Turk Hill Road, Fairport, NY 14450, on Wednesday April 24, 2018, at 7:30 pm, a public hearing will be held to consider amending the above section of the Town Code. A summary of the proposed changes to Chapter 208-23 follows:

- Poultry – The proposed code permits poultry, but limits flock size to three female poultry and requires poultry shelters/coops to be located in the rear yard, set back at least 30 feet away from any property line. Only conventionally zoned residences are able to keep poultry. Clustered and multi- family properties will not comply with the new code.
- Honey Bees – The proposed code permits honey bees on residential properties greater than one (1) acre if the apiaries are located in the rear yard, set back at least 15 feet away from any property line. Residents with property under one (1) acre who wish to keep bees may seek a variance from the Zoning Board of Appeals (ZBA). This allows neighbors to comment on the proposal and provides an opportunity for ZBA members to review the credentials of prospective beekeepers and determine their ability to safely maintain their hives in a smaller setting.

The amended sections of code may be reviewed in the Town Clerk's Office, 1350 Turk Hill Road, Fairport, NY during normal business hours. On said date, time and place the Town Board will hear all persons in support of or in opposition to said amendments. Interested persons wishing to be heard may appear in person, by agent or submit written comments to the Town Clerk.
