## Bushnell's Basin Docks

Some of the docks at Bushnell's Basin will be back and ready to use — free of charge — by Labor Day Weekend. The docks were damaged by ice last winter when the Erie Canal was drained. After weeks of repairs, a portion of the docks were put back in place



August 31. The remaining docks and utilities for overnight docking will be completed in time for the 2019 boating season. The docks, which were opened in July of 2011, have been reinforced in hopes of avoiding problems in the future.
